**HOME BASE SPECIAL EDUCATION SUPPORT 2021-22**

**TERMS AND CONDITIONS:** The Alvord Unified School District (hereinafter, "District") and the Alvord Educators Association (hereinafter, "Association") collectively (hereinafter, "the Parties") agree as follows:

Alvord Unified School District and the Alvord Educators Association agree that due to the uncertainty of the ongoing global pandemic, a Home-Based independent study instructional model was provided to students and families for the 2021-2022 school year.


To assist some of our students with IEP's in the Home Base Independent Study Program, there is a need to adjust classes and provide additional Special Education support. Students that require modified curriculum will be placed in the same class (by grade levels K-5, 6-8, 9-12) with a general education teacher.

In addition, a teacher holding the appropriate Special Education credential will be assigned to each class that requires modified curriculum. This teacher will be paid one hour, per week, per student at the teacher hourly rate and is responsible for all modifications to the curriculum.

The students with IEP's in the Home Base Independent Study Program will keep the same case manager from their home school.

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**PARENT/TEACHER CONFERENCES 2021-22**

**TERMS AND CONDITIONS:** The Alvord Unified School District (hereinafter, "District") and the Alvord Educators Association (hereinafter, "Association") collectively (hereinafter, "the Parties") agree as follows:

Alvord Unified School District and the Alvord Educators Association agree that due to the uncertainty of the ongoing global pandemic, All parent/teacher conferences will be held virtually for the 2021-2022 school year as determined by site administration and parent.

**Elementary**

On the scheduled minimum days, Elementary teachers will schedule parent/teacher conferences with their student's parents/guardians.

Schools have the option to hold evening conferences on Wednesday (October 6<sup>th</sup>). If the school chooses this option, teachers will be able to leave at the end of the instructional day on Friday. This decision will be made by a majority vote of the staff.

The Staff meeting scheduled for October 5<sup>th</sup> will be moved to November 30<sup>th</sup>.

**Middle/High School**

Middle and high school teachers will schedule their parent/teacher conferences on the identified minimum days. These meetings should target students that are at risk of failing, have attendance concerns, or other factors that may be impeding the students' educational progress. If the staff chooses to do an alternate schedule, it will be done after a majority vote by the staff.
